## Earlham Schools 2020-2021

### Elementary Goals

- **Preschool** - Reading: 90% of students will be able to identify 20/26 uppercase and lowercase letters. 90% of students will know 15/26 letter sounds. Math: 90% of students will be able to rote count to 20. 90% of students will be able to identify numbers 0 to 10.
- **Kindergarten** - Reading: Students will achieve level D on the end of year benchmark assessment. Math: 85% of students will meet the Norm Grade Level Mean RIT on the Spring MAP math assessment.
- **1st grade** - Reading: 90% of students will read at an instructional level I/J on the benchmark assessment. Math: 85% of students will meet the grade level norm RIT on the spring MAP assessments.
- **2nd grade** - 90% of students will read at an instructional level M on the benchmark assessment and 90% will have gained at least three reading levels. 90% will meet the grade level norm RIT on spring MAP assessments.
- **3rd grade** - Reading: 90% will read level P with 95% accuracy. By the end of the year, 90% will gain three reading levels. Math: 90% will meet their Spring MAP growth target and 100% of students will show growth in math.
- **4th grade** - Reading: 70% of students will meet the Spring Norm Average RIT with 100% of students showing growth from Fall to Spring on the MAP reading and math assessment.
- **5th grade** - Reading: 90% of students will meet or exceed a level V reading level. Math: 85% of students will achieve a 75% or above on the EOY EM4 assessment. Students who scored at a 75% or above on the BOY EM4 assessment will score a 95% or higher on the EOY assessment.

### District Goals

Each grade level will have at least 80% of students meeting grade level fall benchmark scores on the reading and math MAP assessment. Of those students meeting the fall benchmark, 95% will continue to meet grade level benchmarks in the Spring on the reading and math MAP assessment.

### High School Goals

1. 90% of students in grades 9-12 will earn a 2.0 or better in each course.
2. 90% of students will be either at grade level norm or show growth from Fall to Spring for Spring Reading and Math MAP test.
3. 85% participation rate in one extra-curricular activity and 70% participation rate in two or more extra-curricular activities.

### Middle School Goals

1. 90% of students in grades 6-8 will earn a 2.0 or better in each course.
2. 90% of students will meet or exceed the grade level norm or will show growth from Fall to Spring for Spring Reading and Math MAP test.
